SW News

In SW, we have been studying the life cycle of a chicken. Last year we hatched out some eggs too and some of us remember those little fluff balls...well this year, those fluff balls have grown into those beautiful specimens you may have seen in the MSPS chook run and they are the parents to this new brood of 18 delightful little cheepers.

We have learnt about the different stages of development the chick goes through inside the egg. We have also learnt about what baby chicks need to grow up to be big and strong. After a few red faces and discussions about homophones, we even learnt how to tell the sex of a chicken by looking at how the wing feathers grow.

Our chicks are pure bred Orpington and Barnevelder X Orpington. Orpington's are a large docile English Breed, perfect for families... and Barnevelders are bred for laying plenty of beautiful dark brown eggs. They are for sale for \$15 for the Orpingtons and \$10 for the crosses, which will make eggcellent layers. If you would like to buy some, leave your name and number with the ladies at the office.

Our chicks are talented sports chicks as you can see by the photos. In SW we had a great time on the "Chicken Olympic" photo shoot, although the chicks didn't always do as they were told. They were a competitive bunch, and everyone enjoyed setting the scene for some super-cute happy snaps.

SUMMER SAFETY - HYDRATION

The approach of summer holidays provides more time for kids to get outside and play! Keep in mind that playing in the heat of the summer sun results in more fluid losses.
