PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

Dear Parents and Carers,

Our focus for the fortnight has been resilience. A big part of being resilient as a learner is having the courage to take risks and make mistakes. At Muswellbrook South we are not scared of failure but rather, see the process of learning as an iterative process of 'miss-takes' that lead us to a broader understanding of the world. It's a bit like getting lost. You walk down the wrong path, walk back, try a different route and in time you've developed a significant mental picture of the entire area. Now you can use that map to innovate and find shortcuts. In this way you've learnt through your mistakes. That same process is what we encourage in our classrooms every day. Our students challenge themselves, over-extend and fail. They are then supported by teachers, who scaffold the next steps in learning, leading to a broader and deeper understanding of the content. We want our students to understand that this process of repeated mistakes is a normal part of learning and that it takes courage.

When you're at home with your children try and provide opportunities for them to take controlled risks, encourage their effort and support them when they fall down. Be confident that their small failures will make them stronger and build their resilience and sense of self-confidence.

Please contact the school office to make any updates. Thank you for your cooperation.






