
Well done to all participants!

# Online applications are now open to apply or update details

# To Apply for travel

https://ssts-apply.transport.nsw.gov.au/ApplySSTS/ApplySSTS.html

- If students are going into Kindergarten
- If students are going from Year 2 to 3 (may be automatically be renewed by TfNSW if eligibile)
- If students are going from year 6 to 7 if changing schools

# To Update details

https://ssts-apply.transport.nsw.gov.au/ApplySSTS/UpdateEntitlement.html

If students have had a change of details eg. Change of School, or Address, etc.

To be eligible you must apply online, pending you meet the below criteria. When applying online the TfNSW website will inform you if you are eligible or not. All bus applications enquires can be answered by TfNSW on 131 500.

### Criteria

# Students from Kindergarten-Year 2 are eligible if:

- They are a resident of NSW, or an overseas student eligible for free government education.
- Aged 4 years 6 months, or older.
- No minimum walking distance criteria applies to these students.

# Primary school students from Years 3-6 are eligible if:

- They are a resident of NSW, or an overseas student eligible for free government education.
- The straight line distance from their home address to school is more than 1.6 km.
- The walking distance from home to school is 2.3 km or further.

# Secondary school students from Years 7-12 are eligible if:

- They are a resident of NSW or an overseas student who is eligible for free government education,
- The straight line distance from their home address to school is more than 2 km, or The walking distance from home to school is 2.9 km or further.

### Non-Australian residents and students temporarily in Australia:

- Some students who are not Australian residents or who are temporarily in Australia are eligible for free or subsidised travel, depending on their visa subclass.
- You will need to quote your visa subclass number and the name of the exchange program (if applicable) when applying for the SSTS, in addition to meeting the standard eligibility criteria
