



Cash, Eftpos and Lay-bys are available. Please note all laybys require a regular fortnightly payment. No items can be taken without full payment.



Open 5 days a week 9am to 2.15pm.

Lunch orders must be handed to the canteen before 10am with child's name and class clearly marked on the lunch bag.

No hot food lunch orders will be taken after this time for 1st break. Any hot food orders after 10am will be served at 2nd break. Any frozen treats or Slush Puppies ordered will be highlighted and your child must bring the bag back to the canteen for collection. 2nd break orders have to be

collected from the canteen by the kids themselves, we do not send the lunches to the classrooms. Eftpos is available for adults only. Minimum spend is \$5 on debit card and \$10 on credit card. The canteen cannot give cash out on Eftpos.


