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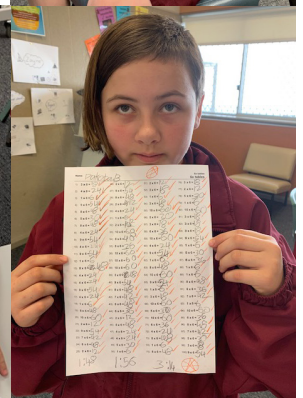
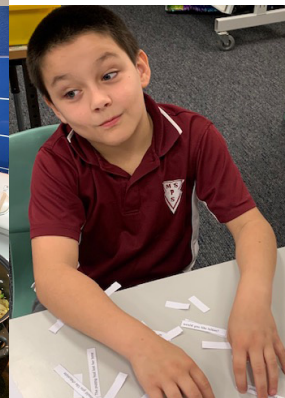
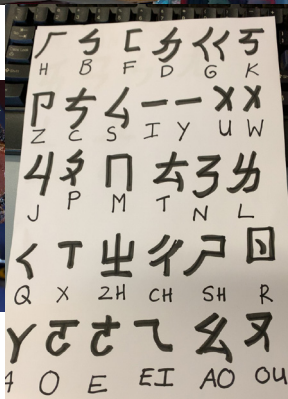
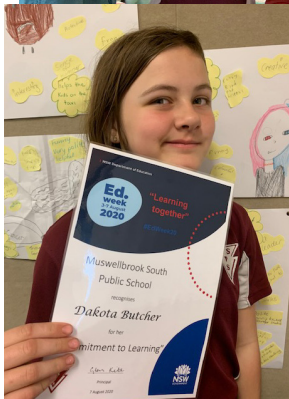
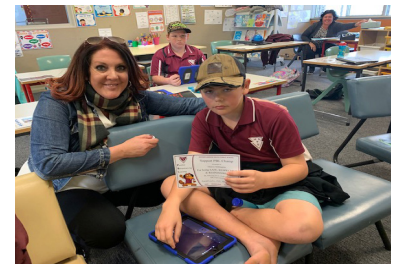
- SUPPORT BLUE NEWS -

Wellbeing Tip ~ Week 6

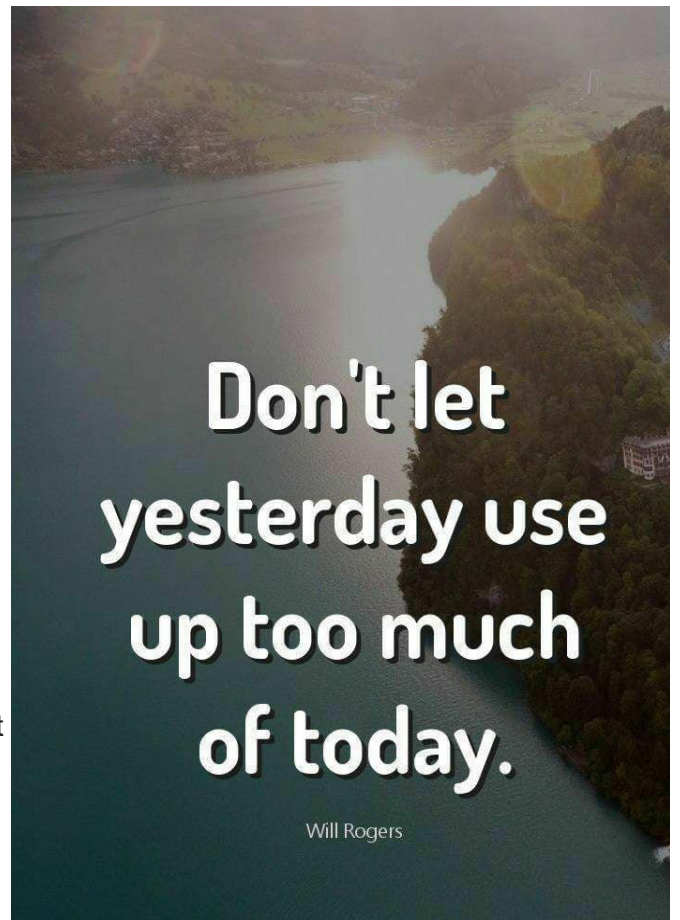
Reflecting on ourselves can be daunting, sobering, unappealing, revealing, refreshing, rewarding or a combination of all of the above.
