FRUIT BREAK

Every day classes will have a 10 minute eating break to have some fruit or vegetables & water. 
MSPS SCHOOL SPORTS DAYS

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

ABSENCES

It is a Department of Education requirement that whenever your child is absent from school, unless it is on school business such as attending an excursion, you are obligated to provide a note explaining their absence. If your child is late to school, or you need to pick them up early, students will come to the office and collect a late note or an early leaver's slip, which will be given to their teacher. You can also notify the school if your child is away through the Sentral Parent Portal app or phone the school on 0265 431 896.

PUBLICITY & GENERAL CONSENT PERMISSION FORMS

Publicity & General Consent forms are filled out at time of enrolment. When these forms are completed, parents/carers answer if they give or do not give consent to publicity such as student's photographs being included in school newsletters, on the school Facebook page, local newspapers, Department of Education Internet pages, television, radio, taken on school photo day and to be published out in the community. There is no need for this form to be completed each year. Completed forms are kept in the student's file. If a form has not been completed a new one will be sent home in the coming weeks. Please complete this and send back to school at your earliest convenience. If you have completed a publicity consent form but now/ later wish to make changes, please notify the school in writing so we can adjust our records accordingly. Thank you very much for your cooperation.

ASSEMBLIES

Assemblies will be held throughout the term to recognise student achievements. Assembly dates are published on the term calendar included in the fortnightly newsletter. Support classes hold an assembly each fortnight and a whole school assembly will be held twice a term. Other special assemblies may also be held throughout the year in which information will be provided.

All assemblies will be held in the school hall.

Parents will be advised if their child is receiving an award. Parents and friends are welcome to attend.

PUBLISHING STUDENT PHOTOGRAPHS

Schools, parents and friends like to acknowledge the wonderful achievements of students. It is great to see lots of parents and friends attend our events, assemblies etc. Please keep in mind when you are posting photos or videos to social media, that not all of our students have permission to publish their image online.

Photos containing only your child can be posted on social media, however if they contain other students please do not publish them.

STUDENT DETAILS AND EMERGENCY CONTACTS

It is important that you notify the school office of changes that occur to student's contact details e.g. new phone numbers, change of address etc. Emergency contact details also need to be kept up-to-date with current working phone numbers. **We also would like an email address for each family** as we move emailing notes home to parents.

It is important to have up-to-date details as this information is sometimes needed by teachers, to approve transport applications, in the event of an emergency and to provide specific information e.g. excursion updates.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

WARRAE WANNI

Students will be commencing on Monday 19 February from 9.30am to 2.30pm. Families will be notified. Please ensure your child brings a back pack with lunch box including fruit for morning tea and water. Please also include a change of clothes.

PARKING

Parking at the school is very restricted at the moment due to building works happening at the TAFE. Please allow extra time to find a park in surrounding streets and safely walk your child in to school. Osborn Ave gates are open each day until 10am and reopen in the afternoon at 3pm. Osborn Ave can get very busy & congested. If you are using the designated 'Two minute drop zone' please do so and safely move on. Please DO NOT park in surrounding businesses carparks (Mobil Service Station, Osborn Bus Company, Beaurepaires) as it obstructs access for their customers and suppliers and can be a safety concern. Thanking you in advance for your cooperation.

ROAD SAFETY

For the safety of students and adults, please make sure road rules are followed at all times. Speed limits must be adhered to around surrounding streets. Children under the age of 10 must hold a parents hand when crossing roads. At no time should pedestrians walk through the staff carpark or driveway gates. Please use walkways and gates. Thank you for your cooperation.

BREAKFAST CLUB

Breakfast Club is open again for 2024.

Breakfast is served from the canteen between 8.45am and 9.15am every school morning. Children can get a piece of toast, juice, milo and cereal.

Please come along if you have not had time to have brekky at home, or just want to have breakfast at South with your friends. Come along and share a story with friends whilst enjoying a healthy start to the day.

SMART WATCHES

This year, a lot of our students have returned to school wearing a smart watch. Some of these have the function for students to take photos from them, to receive messages and calls and to send messages or calls. This is effectively the same as having a mobile phone at school.

Please ensure your child's watch is set to 'Class Mode' so that they are unable to perform the above functions, as it becomes an issue of privacy and distraction.

MOBILE PHONES

Mobile phones are not permitted at school. If you need to get in contact with your child while they are at school, please call the office to leave a message. If your child carries a phone on them due to after school arrangements, they are expected to take it to the front office at the start of the day and pick it up when the school day finishes.

UNIFORM

Students are required to wear full school uniform. This includes socks. Boys are required to wear grey or plain white socks (**NO** Santa Cruz socks). This is available to view on the school website and to purchase from the uniform Shop. If you are having trouble meeting these requirements please speak to your child's classroom teacher. Please also be aware that minimal jewellery is allowed, such as studs or sleepers and a watch. Costume jewellery, rings, bracelets (unless it is a medical bracelet) or necklaces are not to be worn as it is a safety hazard. Girls can wear scrunchies and bows in their hair, however, we ask that they are white or maroon only.



NAPLAN

National Assessment Program - Literacy and Numeracy Information for parents and carers

- All students in Years 3, 5, 7 and 9 in Australia do NAPLAN tests in March each year.
- NAPLAN tests students' skills in reading, writing and maths.
- The test questions are presented in Standard Australian English dialect.
- Students read some of the questions and listen to others with headphones.
- The tests will get easier or harder, depending on how students are going in the test.
- Students do four different tests. The names of the four tests are:



- Students in Year 3 will do the Writing test using pencil and paper. Year 3 students will answer the other test questions on the computer.
- Students in Years 5, 7 and 9 will answer all their test questions on computers.
- Teachers will help students get ready for NAPLAN tests.
- Schools will get their students' results. The school will then give parents/carers a report showing their own child's results.
- Parents/carers can talk to the teacher about these results.

• NAPLAN shows how students are going all over Australia. People who work in the Australian Government, state and territory education authorities and schools use NAPLAN results. The results let them see which schools are doing well and which schools might need help.







We have transitioned smoothly to our new School Bytes finance system. You can access School Bytes either via the Parent Portal website or via the School Bytes app (NEW).



School Bytes parent portal enables you to view all your children in one portal and process payments for multiple siblings in one transaction.

Once your portal is activated you can use it to give consent for events and process online payments. **To make an online payment -**

1. Log into the parent portal – <u>https://portal.schoolbytes.education/auth/login</u> or via School Bytes App.

2. Select the statement of account icon.

3. Select the charges to pay.

By default, all the students linked to your account will be displayed, select a student's name to view the charges linked with that student.

If the charge is related to an activity consent must be given before making payment.

4. Confirm or edit the balance to be paid for each charge (if required).

5. Optionally select 'add other item' to add a sundry item (e.g. Year 6 graduation souvenir) that is not linked to the statement of account. When adding a new sundry item, select the relevant student.

6. Select pay now (optionally select pay with saved credit card details if previously saved).

7. Review payment details.

9. Select pay. You will be redirected to a secure Service NSW payment page to enter your credit/debit card details to finalise payment.

10. Payment successful. Click anywhere outside the receipt prompt to return to the parent portal. A receipt will be automatically emailed to you.

Cash payments can still be made at school. Please note receipts for these cash payments will be emailed to the email address held on file at school. Please contact the school if you need to update your email address.

Bus Flashing Lights Campaign Term 1 2024 from Monday 29 January 2024 - Friday 23 February 2024



Slow down to 40km/h when bus lights flash, unless a lower speed limit applies.

Key Messages Motorists

- Lights flash on buses to warn motorists that buses are picking up and dropping off children You must slow down to 40km/h when overtaking or passing a bus displaying flashing lights,
- unless a lower speed limit applies.
- You can help keep children safe by: Sticking to the speed limit and following the road rules in school zones
- Slowing down to 40km/h when bus lights are flashing, unless a lower speed limit applies
- Looking out for children crossing the road near bus stops, in school zones or along bus routes
- Giving way to buses when they merge back into traffic.

Families

Celebrating

- Families have an important part to play in keeping children safe around roads. Never drop off or meet your child on the opposite side of the road to the bus stop or call them
- across the road. Always drop them off or meet them on the same side of the road as the bus stop.
- Remind your children to always wait until the bus has gone before choosing a safe Talk to your children about Stop! Look! Listen! Think! every time they cross the road:
- Stop one step back from the kerb Look continuously both ways
- Listen for the sounds of approaching traffic Think whether it is safe to cross and keep checking until safely across.
